# Learning model

We are waiting for further information from the authorities regarding updates to the current regulations, which may affect our learning model. We hope to have all students in school and remain optimistic about this, but if the regulations remain the same as last academic year, then this will be the plan for Term 1:

- Year 7: Students in school 100% mini-learning plaza in the Small Hall where half the year group will be on rotation accessing their teacher virtually. The Head of Year 7 will send the rotation schedule to you.
- Year 8: Blended approach students in school 50% rotation to be sent out by Head of Year 8 if this goes ahead.
- Years 9-13: Students in school 100% taught across two rooms by their classroom teacher for LEAD/subjects.

We will of course update you when we receive any updates. The plan above will be reviewed at the end of Term 1 *if* it goes ahead.

# Uniform

As you will be aware, we have modified some of the uniform for this academic year. We are working with Threads to ensure that it will all be available for you in store by the 25<sup>th</sup> August. Due to Covid and the late shipping of the new school uniform, students will be able to wear the old PE kit until the end of September. New students and those who have outgrown their uniform will be given permission to wear a plain white t-shirt and plain navy blue short or trousers for the month of September on their PE day. Some parents have also asked about purchasing the MTS school bag; this will not be mandatory for this academic year, however, we do encourage you to replace your child's current bag with the MTS branded one when a replacement is necessary.

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### Devices

The aim is that all students with an Apple device will have the e-safety app installed for safety and access reasons, and we will be phasing this in throughout the term. As for Apple devices, we shall be phasing these in (and any non-Apple devices phased out) throughout this academic year. We ask that parents who are replacing student devices which are old/no longer work, do so with an Apple product. A reminder of devices required:

Year group	Device required
7 and 8	<ul> <li>iPad and Keyboard</li> <li>This can be the same device that the student has used in Year 6</li> <li>We recommend you to purchase an iPad Magic keyboard or Logitech Folio Touch Keyboard. Approximate costs for these are between 500 – 1000 AED</li> </ul>
Year 9	<ul> <li>If the iPad that was purchased is still supported by the latest iPadOS then it would be more cost effective to continue using the iPad and keyboard set-up</li> <li>If the current iPad is no longer supported by the latest iPadOS, or the child wishes to move to a full size device, a MacBook can be purchased</li> <li>No new device expectation unless the device is obsolete and/or no longer supports iPadOS</li> </ul>
10 to 13	<ul> <li>Students should be moving to use of a MacBook, which they will use throughout Years 10-13</li> <li>The student's current iPad may still be necessary for certain GCSE, A-Level, and BTEC courses.</li> <li>We appreciate that there may be a transitional period where students move from an iPad to a</li> </ul>

#### PCR Testing before returning to school

Please note that if your son/daughter has travelled over the break, they need to have been back in the UAE for 10 days before coming into school (and be symptom-free), or have a negative PCR result from a clinic in Dubai taken within 48 hours of returning to school (if they have been back in the country less than 10 days).
