
English

Mathematics

The children will be looking at varied fluency, reasoning and problemsolving skills. We will be building our ability to reason effectively and proving our answers in particular this term.

Each week we will also have an arithmetic day where we will learn one objective and then complete a test.

Here are our objectives:

Fractions

LO: To identify equivalent fractions

LO: To convert improper fractions to mixed numbers

LO: To convert mixed numbers to improper fractions

LO: To count backwards and forwards in fractions

LO: To compare and order fractions lesson than 1

LO: To compare and order fractions greater than 1

LO: To add and subtract fractions with the same denominator

LO: To add fractions with different denominators within1

LO: to add 3 or more fractions with different denominators

LO: to add fractions of different denominators

LO: to add mixed numbers

LO: to subtract fractions with different denominators

LO: subtract a fraction from a mixed number

LO: to subtract mixed numbers

LO: to multiply a fraction by an integer

LO: to multiply a non-unit fraction by an integer

LO: To multiply a mixed number by an integer

LO: To calculate the fraction of a quantity (RECOVERY)

LO: To find the fraction of an amount



Art and Music

In art, the children will be continuing to develop their line, shading and pattern skills.

Computer Science

In Year 5 ICT the students will learn to code, using SCRATCH and SWYFT PLAYGROUND. We will understand how computers and technology work and how computers process instructions and commands using coding languages.

Moral education and UAE Social Studies

In social studies, we will be looking at UAE celebrations and climates. In moral education, we will be learning about trade and travel.

<u>PE</u> Badminton

Children will use different types of serves in-game and new shots. They will learn to play effectively with eachother and move confidently with effective footwork.

Topic Titanic and The Arctic

For this topic, the children will learn about the history of the Titanic and investigating what life was like, who was to blame and developing their historical research skills.

We will investigate animals, and the inhabitants of the Arctic and compare it to the UAE and the UK. We will also compare climates across the world and look at how we can help save the Arctic through becoming more economically friendly.

<u>Science</u>

Living things and their habitats

For science, the children will be looking at mammals, birds, amphibians and insects' life cycles and how they reproduce. On top of this, we will be investigating the life of different plants.
