Forest School

Welcome to our Forest school. This is where any good story starts, through the gate and into the forest where the adventure begins.

Forest school is a long term outdoor programme of learning delivered by our trained practitioners, in a natural environment. Our programme is tailor made to the needs of your children as they grown in confidence, skills and understanding in order to support them in their first exploration of leadership.

We are fortunate to be the proud owners of a brand new, world class forest school facility which includes, a woodland walk, an outdoor classroom and growing gardens. Along the way there will be many more features added as we watch how the children use the space and adapt it for them.

The forest school sessions build on what the children are currently learning in their topic and across the curriculum or will consolidate prior learning. The children are encouraged and supported in recognising risk and managing this for themselves, through real life situations and experiences.











Term 1A

Moon Zoom!

Our first term in Year 1 will be out of this world. In our topic Moon Zoom! our exciting adventure will begin igniting the children's interests by discovering a Space craft Crash Landing in the GEMS Metropole's Forest School. The children will find clues and predict who has crashed their space craft, where they came from and why they are here. With the support of engaging key texts such as 'How to Catch a Star' and 'Beegu' the children will learn a range of key language to enrich their learning. An educational trip to the Sharjah Plantetarium will give the children an insight into the world above them and spark the question 'Is there anybody else out there?'. Throughout the topic children will be thinking about ways we could travel into space and as a celebration of learning, we will invite parents to design and build a rocket that could fly into space!



Term 1B

Excellent Explorers. Where would you like to explore?

To start this exciting topic, the children will find that somebody has set up camp in our school, and this is filled with clues about who is here. The children will investigate what they have found to work out who they think has been camping in our school and where they are from. This will hook the children in to our new topic, Excellent Explorers! During the topic, the children will be learning about significant explorers who were some of the first to travel to unseen parts of the world. The children will be encouraged to think about what these expeditions would have been like and whether they would like to take on an adventure similar. To end our topic, the children will be deisgning a snow mobile, similar to the ones used by the explorers taught during our topic. These will be put into an exhibition ready for you to come and admire our amazing inventions.

Term 2A

Paws, claws and whiskers. Do all animals crawl?

Our new topic will start with the children taking a trip down to the GEMS Metropole farm, where they will discover videos that have been left by the talking animals. This will excite the children into wanting to know more about these farm animals as well as animals from all around the world. The children will build on their explorer skills from their previous topic and travel to different contintents to learn about different types of animals. The children will be encouraged to think about how our planet is changing and what we can do to protect endangered animals. To end our topic, the children will use their knowledge of their favourite endagered animal to educate and bring awareness to others by creating and sharing their own YouTube channel.



Term 2B

Dinosaurs. Are dinosaurs really extinct?



Have you ever wondered what it would be like if Dinosaurs were still alive? Well you might just be about to find out! To kickstart our new topic Dinosaurs, we will discover clues in the playground and be shown some top secret CCTV footage that shows us a T-rex is in our school! Throughout the term we will become Palaeontologists, using tools and digging deep into the ground to discover fossils and clues from that past, we will visit the Dinosaur Park to see some 'real' dinsours. Let's not forget a Dinosaur is loose in the school and as Palaeontologists Year 1 are the only ones who are equipped to catch him. Using our knowledge and what we have learnt this term the children will design and build traps to catch the dinosaur and return him to a suitable habitat.

Term 3A

Bright lights, big cities. If you could live in any city, where would you live?

If money was no object, where would you go? Well during this topic the children are going to enter their classroom, which will have been transformed into an airport check in. They will design and make their own passport and earn stamps as and when they travel to a new continent during the topic. The children will be learning about different countries from around the world and what makes them so special; from what delicacies they eat and what magical celebrations they share. Throughout the topic, children will have lots of opportunities to explore different countries through food tasting, dressing up and learning new skills. We will complete the topic with an all around the world celebration, where we will celebrate the diversity of our school and the children have the opportunity to show off how proud they are of where they come to.



Term 3B

Land Ahoy. Would you like to be a pirate?



Yo ho ho a pirates term for me! For our final topic the children will discover a message in a bottle from a pirate! The message will also include a treasure map for the children to use to go on a treasure hunt. They will need to keep their eyes peeled incase the pirate is still lurking around school... During this topic the children will learn about pirates and seaside towns, focusing on human and physical features. Towards the end of the topic, children will design and make their own treasure chest. They will also create their own treasure map and parents will be invited in to join us on our
