

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will be exploring the place value of numbers up to 4 digits and looking at different ways of reading and representing them. We will also work on

- Ordering numbers
- Finding 1,10,100 more or less than a number
- Rounding numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000
- Counting back in negative numbers
- Roman numerals
- Counting in 25

We will then be moving on to working on Addition and Subtraction and using formal written methods to show our working out.

Year 4 – Autumn Term 1A


<u>Topic</u>

To start off our year, the children will be going on a historical journey back to the Roman Empire to learn how the Romans came to conquer Britain, why they left and what impact they made.

Reading

The children will be working on a range of different text types such as narratives; explanation texts and poetry and building on their reading skills such as making predictions and reading for clarification.

<u>Writing</u>

In English, the children will be focusing on developing their writing through narrative genres using the texts 'Escape from Pompeii' and 'Macbeth'. They will work on grammar skills such as using expanded noun phrases, adverbial phrases, direct speech and punctuation to develop excitement and detail in their writing.

Throughout the term children will be working on spelling rules from the Year 4 curriculum

<u>Science</u>

The children will be learning about 'Animals including humans' throughout Term IA. This will entail understanding:

- The different parts of the digestive system and their functions.
- Comparing human teeth to animal teeth
- Food chains and how they link together.

Lessons will include research, practical and investigative work.

Computer Science

Throughout Term IA children will; learn how to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly. They will also identify ways to report concerns online.

Moral Education and UAE Social Studies

In Moral Education children will be learning about Equality, Appreciation. They will be describing what treating people equally means and distinguish cases of treating people equally and treating people fairly.

In Social Studies students will learn about how significant figures, events, and developments have impact and play a role in constituting other communities in the region over different eras and in different places.

Art

Children will improve their mastery design techniques in drawing, painting and sculpture. They will use a range of materials such as; pencils; charcoal, paints and clay.

<u>Music</u>

Children will be learning about the structure of songs linked to literacy. We will focus on the music and styles of the 70s and 80s.

Pupils will use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. They will analyse performances by listening and appraising

<u>Arabic</u>

Children will be studying the following topics:

- Visit to the city of beauty.
- Tour in my school.
- Around UAE.
- Famous races.
- Be my guest.

<u>PE</u>

This will be a safe reintroduction to practical PE, with careful consideration to social distancing guidelines. Students will work through a number of adapted lessons in Gymnastics focusing on; fundamental movements, balance, mirror/matching, rolls and flight.
