Science


In science, we will be developing our knowledge about how light travels and how we are able to see. We will also explore some of the ways that light behaves, such as shadows, reflection and refraction.

Maths

English

During English this half term,
Year six will be exploring
balanced arguments through

will be able to research, plan
and write a balanced
argument and participate in
an informal debate with
arguments and counterarguments.

Topic

Our first topic this year is 'Crime and Punishment'.

We will be comparing various historical periods and their outlook on crime and the punishments used at the time. We will also be exploring maps to make geographical comparisons and develop our knowledge of the location of countries and cities.

PE

For Basketball the students will be applying fitness to the game such as power and strength. Choose and implement arrange of strategies to play offensively and defensively. Grasp more technical aspects of the game. Focus to be paid to leadership and communication skills.

<u>Art</u>

Year 6 will be introduced to Banksy and gather prior knowledge on the artist. They will gain a greater understanding of his work, and start to experiment using the techniques by the artist. They will use his work as inspiration to create some Banksy art work.

Moral Education

Our half termly focus is 'Character and Morality'. During this unit of work, the children will explain the meaning of moral values and how they perceive ethical dilemmas.

Spanish

The children will have an introduction into the language and begin with greetings and talking about themselves.

Social Studies

In Social Studies, the children will be learning about ancient civilisations and their impact on the world we live in today.

French

The children will be building on their basic French language patterns, by practising how to greet people, and how to introduce and discuss a little about themselves.
