Preparing students

Mock Exams: I'd like to congratulate our Year 11 and 13 students on the way they have conducted themselves throughout their mock exams this week. Students behaved maturely and respectfully, appreciating how valuable this experience is in preparing them for the final GCSE/A-Level exams. Students will receive their results on 'Mock Exam Results Day' by opening an envelope to reveal their grades mirroring how the actual results day will work!

Year 9 Careers Day: Our Year 9 Careers Day will take place on Sunday 28th November throughout the day, which will involve students completing tasks and listening to teachers and members of our community talk through their career and how they got there, with the aim to inspire and motivate students to think about their future plans. We hope our students feel motivated from these presentations and activities, and that they give them food for thought when considering university and the world of work.

GCSE/A-Levels/BTEC Options Process: We are beginning the options process for our current Year 9 and Year 11 students who will soon be thinking about the GCSE/A-Level/BTEC subjects they would like to take. This starts with students completing a survey (link in Weekly Sway) of subjects they are interested in, followed by subject taster sessions, open evenings and student interviews.
