We had two exciting events take place this week: International Day on Wednesday where Secondary students visited a range of stalls, watched cultural performances, and completed activities during lessons. World Book Day took place on Thursday 3rd March - students came to school dressed as their favourite literary character/book and completed reading activities with their subject teachers throughout the day.

Changes to Covid-19 Protocols

You will be aware that there have been some changes to Covid-19 Protocols. This news is excellent and shows we are moving in the right direction. However, we continue to put the health and safety of our school community first and ensure high standards are maintained. The new guidelines are as follows:

- ned. The new guidelines are as follows: Staff, parents, visitors, and students must continue to wear their mask whilst inside the school building
- Close-contacts can attend school physically if they are asymptomatic
- If close-contacts are symptomatic, they will need to do two PCR tests (48 hours apart) and only return to school if both are negative and all symptoms are cleared. Students must get a clearance letter from the school clinic to return to class
- If the test is positive, students must isolate for 10 days starting from the date of PCR test sample collection
- Symptomatic close contacts and those who tested positive will have access to online classes
