In English, we will be writing a narrative based on The Zoo by Anthony Browne and a newspaper article based on Goldilocks.


We will be looking at:

Science

In Science this term we will be learning all about forces. We will plan and carry out a range of investigations. We will be looking at:

- The effects of gravity on falling objects
- The effects of friction on objects
- Exploring the effects of air and water resistance
- The uses of levers, pulleys and gears
- Researching the contributions of Newton and Galileo






Maths

In Maths we will be looking at fractions:

- Identify equivalent fractions
- Compare and order fractions
- Add and subtract fractions
- Multiplying fractions
- Fraction of an amount



Topic

We will be time-travelling back to AD900 to find out about Ancient Islamic Civilisation. We will then compare this with the Ancient Maya and Benin Civilisations.

- To find out about the past from a range of sources
- To identify what life was like in all three civilisations
- To compare the writing systems of ancient civilisations
- Make comparisons between the three civilisations
- To order events chronologically
- To explore the life of Prophet Muhammed (PBUH)
- To explore the Golden Age of Islamic Civilisations



Modern Foreign Languages French

This term, students will learn how to order food and drinks in a French café. Students will learn typical greetings/useful phrases that one might use at a restaurant and will have many opportunities to role-play scenarios in class.

Spanish

This term, students will study their new topic, 'Mi Casa' (My Home). Students will learn to describe what rooms there are and are not in their home, and will develop their skills by using connectives to link two sentences together.
