School E-safety MDM Platform

- What is the MDM MDM stands for mobile device management system. It is a system which allows devices to be monitored by teachers during school hours.
- Why do they need it The system ensures that students have access to all educational apps which are paid for by school. This ensures that lessons run smoothly with students having access to what they need. It also removes distractions and ensures that students are safe online because it limits student access to other applications and potentially harmful websites.
- Can we stop VPNs The MDM will remove any VPN apps however it cannot control VPNs which are installed on the settings app. It is a parent responsibility to monitor whether students have a VPN installed.
- What devices should students have Please see the attached buying guide which outlines which devices are needed in each area of the school.
- What does it prevent Misuse of technology, access to harmful websites and removes distractions.

 How do I download MBM into my child's ipad? Visit the JTRS Office or see them in school during the following times:

Tuesday 27th September 7:30am-10am

Thursday 29th September - 12.30pm

Friday 30th September - 7:30am

- Is the MDM for phones? The school MDM is only for iPads and MacBooks.
- Will my child receive an Apple ID with iCloud storage? Yes, these are being populated and will be shared with you in the near future. They have 200gb of iCloud storage.
- When is the deadline to enroll my device? From 1st October, there will be no access to wifi in school for students who are not enrolled onto the MDM (with the exception of Sixth Form students).





The Happy Meet will take place on Wednesday 28th September from 10.30am - 11.30am.


