Walking around school this week, I was delighted to see so many moments when our students demonstrated Agility. One example was when I spoke with a Year 4 student about their learning, and they shared how "agility helped me be a risk taker by taking a Gold Task when normally I complete a Silver task in lessons". In school, we use Talking Corners as a strategy to help our students to resolve conflicts. Talking Corners is another way we demonstrate our Agility by listening to others and being open to their opinion and feelings. Finally, trying new creative ways to do things is something we pride ourselves on at our school. Our Junior Duke of Edinburgh has over 260 students signed up this year! This programme is a wonderful opportunity for students to challenge themselves and provides the perfect platform to demonstrate Agility to achieve their goals.

Next week, we will share, celebrate and demonstrate empathy with our students just before we begin our half-term break.




Dear Community,





