



Term 1A: Earth & Space: How did space exploration change the world and show the power of leadership?

English:

This term in English, children will be exploring adventure narratives through writing their own "there and back again" stories.

They will focus on developing characters as they tell the story of an astronaut who travels into space, faces an unexpected challenge, and overcomes it. Building on this, the children will then write a journal from the astronaut's perspective, using the experience of a space mission gone wrong to develop their skills in informative writing.

Art:

This term in Art, students will explore a variety of pastel techniques and apply them in a fun and imaginative project. They will create their own solar system using oil pastels, experimenting with various techniques.

Students will also learn about the element of art - shape and use this knowledge to design creative rockets composed of different shapes. Imagination and individuality will be celebrated as students are encouraged to express their ideas boldly through their work.

PE:

Students will complete a variety of PE and Sports Leadership strands.

PE teachers will inform parents in advance of when swimming will take place throughout the year.

Maths:

Pupils will begin the year by strengthening their understanding of number and place value, working with numbers up to 1,000,000. They will then apply this knowledge to written methods, problem solving, and mental strategies. They will also cover the following objectives:

- Read, write, compare, order, and round numbers up to 1,000,000
- Use and interpret Roman numerals
- Apply formal written methods for addition and subtraction
- Solve multi-step word problems
- Estimate and check answers using inverse operations
- Solve missing number problems
- Consolidate mental arithmetic through weekly 'Race to Mars' challenges
- Practise mental strategies such as counting in powers of ten, partitioning, and quick recall of number facts

Music:

The first topic in YR5 Music is Ukuleles. Children will learn how to play the ukulele as a class ensemble. They will learn chord shapes, strumming patterns and chord progressions. Each lesson will involve learning new chords and jamming along with our wide selection of backing tracks.

MFL:

Spanish: Students will revise numbers with a focus on counting in multiples of 5. Students will also learn about telling the time.

French: Students will revise numbers and telling the time. Students will learn about breakfast foods and saying what they had for breakfast. They will also learn how to conjugate regular -er verbs.

Science:

This term in Science, Year 5 will explore *Earth and Space*. Students will learn about the movement of the Earth, Moon, and planets in relation to the Sun. They'll describe the Sun as a source of light and understand how shadows and day/night occur.

Through investigations, models and observations, children will compare the sizes and positions of celestial bodies and explain how the Earth's rotation causes day and night. Vocabulary will include orbit, rotation, axis and solar system. Activities will support scientific enquiry and build understanding of our planet's place in space.

Arabic B:

In this unit, students will explore the school environment and learn vocabulary for school places and subjects. They'll focus on using the past tense with "I" and "We" (e.g., "I went," "We studied").

Through reading, listening, speaking, and writing activities, they'll describe a past school tour and talk about where they went and what they learned. Support includes past tense verbs, sentence starters, and visuals to help build confidence and fluency.
